Junebug's music has been placed on MN Original and in television programming in Europe.

Notable performances include the legendary Basilica Block Party, and playing the main stage Twin Cities Pride Festival a number of years. Junebug has played numerous shows at such celebrated Twin Cities venues as the Fine Line Music Café, the Varsity Theater, the Ritz Theater, Bunker's, the Triple Rock, the Uptown Bar and many more. In addition to the many shows in the Twin Cities, Junebug actively plays road shows in Minnesota, the Dakotas, Iowa and Wisconsin, with plans to branch out further in the future.

Junebug has performed on bills with the Jayhawks, The Black Crowes, The Village People, The New Congress, Kevin Bowe + the Okemah Prophets, Jon Wayne & the Pain, Heatbox, Mayda, and Solid Gold among others.
